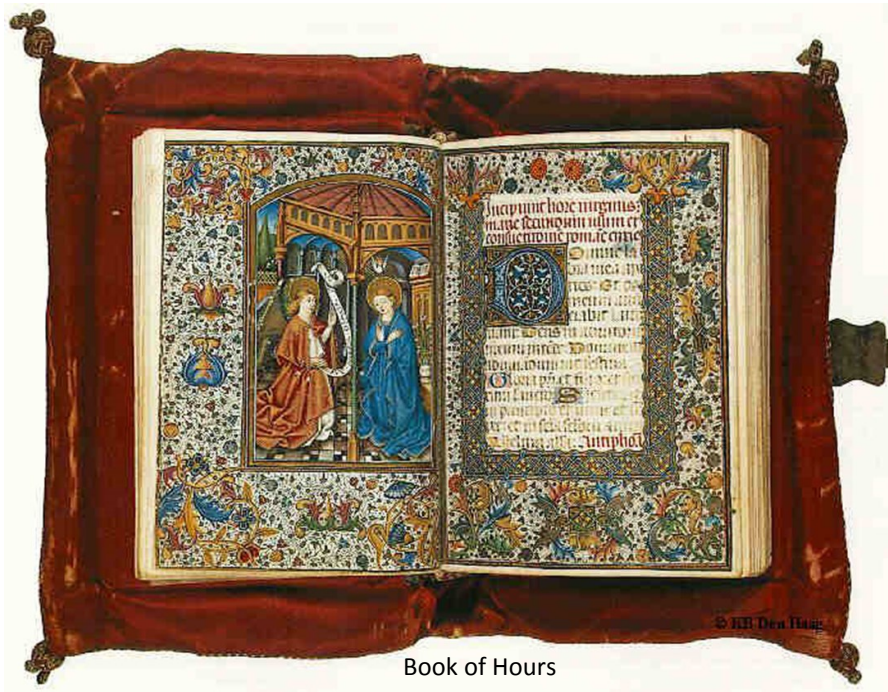
Pala period, early 12th century.

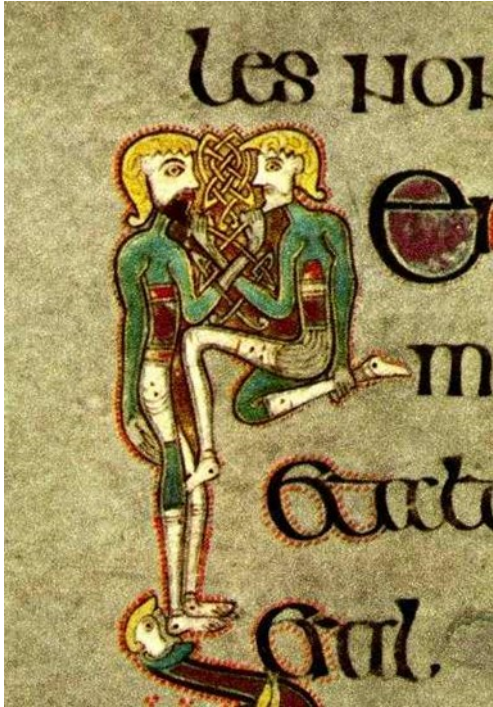

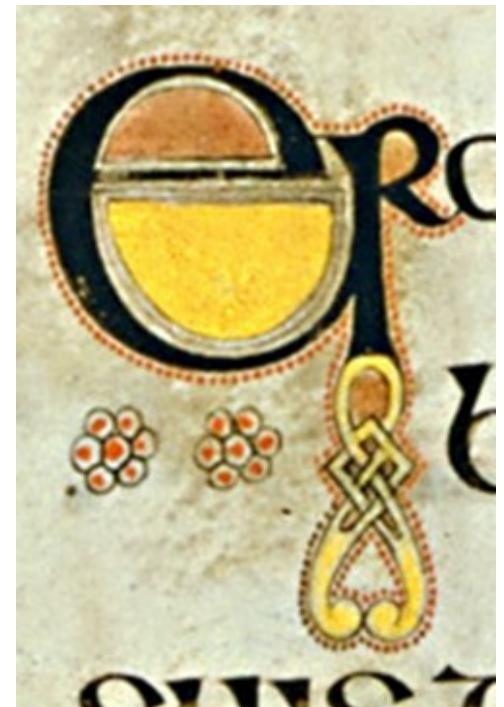
